Kahoot – Classroom Questioning

- ▶ In this activity the students engage with a set of short key terms using a classroom questionin tool such as **Kahoot**.
- ▶ This activity helps with retrieval practice, students test their recall of basic terms they will have read or learnt in a previous lecture, i.e. interleaving topics – so something done three weeks ago, two weeks go etc.

Learning types
This activity would drive the 10% (acquisition).

In this activity, Michael Cole, Senior Lecturer in Sports Therapy at the University of East London asks his students to engage in a series of questions from topics that he will be covering or has previously covered. This activity is typically 10 mins of a class and aids simple recall, tests pre-class reading or watching and can have a level of interleaving.

Interleaving when topics from previous weeks are tested to strengthen recall and memory.

Using the kahoot platform, students can see where their understanding is, in relation to the rest of their peers. The lecturer also clears up any misunderstanding of the fundamental concepts, so that more complex tasks can be tackled.
